

As the capacity of our Nursery/ Children's Centre increases we are experiencing serious problems in relation to parking, for both members of staff and families using our centre.

Understandably, the residents of Glebe Avenue have expressed their concerns regarding the issue and we are presently working closely with both the Neighbourhood Watch and Local Police to develop strategies to ease the congestion.

Therefore we would ask that you walk to the Nursery/ Children's Centre as a preferred option.

If you are an essential car user please could you please ensure that you:-

Park sensitively

Avoid blocking the neighbour's driveways

Make sure the pavement is accessible for Pushchairs and Wheelchairs

Avoid double parking so Emergency Vehicles have access.

Or

“Ride and Stride” (ie: Park in adjoining streets to ease the congestion!)

Please do not park on the Yellow Zig-Zag lines.

We are extremely concerned that if we do not adhere to these guidelines it could result in a serious accident, which would be extremely distressing

BEDWORTH HEATH NURSERY SCHOOL & CHILDREN'S CENTRE WRAP-AROUND

Bedworth Heath Nursery wrap-around is situated in the Maples (Children's Centre). This facility is to extend the hours that the Nursery provides in order to offer parents a wrap-around care service.

The Supervisor & Deputy Supervisor of the wrap-around, are qualified & experienced to work with children. We provide appropriate experiences and children can have access to a variety of books, toys & equipment. There is also the opportunity for rest and relaxation.

Children may attend lunch club. If they attend the morning Nursery session they will be collected from the Nursery. If they attend the afternoon Nursery session they will be taken into Nursery. Children can also attend for afternoon sessions and tea club.

Our Aims

- ❖ to provide high quality childcare in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere for children before going into Nursery or after leaving Nursery
- ❖ to make the childcare as welcoming, enjoyable and comfortable as possible
- ❖ to organise a range of activities, experiences and learning opportunities which are appropriate to children's abilities whilst in our care
- ❖ to work in partnership with parents and Nursery staff

Allocation of Places

The wrap-around facility is available to all Bedworth Heath Nursery School children, subject to booking & availability. The wrap-around has an 'allocation of places' policy which gives priority for places;

- (a) to children referred by partner agencies
- (b) to parents who are working
- (c) to parents who are in training
- (d) to parents who require a place for any other reason

Priority will be given to those parents requiring full-time places & spare sessions offered thereafter.



Opening Hours

Hours of opening are 8am-5.30pm. The facility is open all year but closed for all bank holidays and between Christmas and New Year.

Bookings

Bookings should be made in advance, in person, with Karen in the Nursery School office.

As we are fully Ofsted registered, you may be able to claim upto 80% of these childcare costs back if you are in receipt of Family Tax Credit. Please see Karen in the Nursery Office

Absence

All absences – whether through illness or on holiday, will be charged at the full-rate. Please telephone to let us know if your child will be absent. Parents will not be charged when the Children’s Centre is shut.

Collection

In line with Nursery policy, parents/carers must make it known to Staff who will be collecting their child. Please ensure that children are collected at the agreed time. Any lateness will be charged – please see separate contract.

Refreshments

Children should bring a packed lunch in a cool-bag or similar. Please do not send drinks in glass containers. Please make sure that lunch boxes/bags are clearly marked with child’s name. Morning & afternoon snack, together with a light tea are provided.

Concerns

If any matter arises to cause concern or parent/carers find any aspect of wrap-around to be unsatisfactory, please contact the Supervisor who will deal with the matter. If it cannot be resolved in this way, please speak to the Headteacher.
